# Auction Participants

## Now Hear This! We have rules.

### Over 50 Flamingo Philanthropy auction items to delight you!

1. Welcome Aboard – and Good Luck! Be sure to pick up your bid card/auction number when you arrive at the Reception/Ticket Desk. You will use the number on your bid card for silent auction bid sheets, and you will raise it for the live auction action. It looks something like this:



Please fill in your name on the card.

2. Remember we are fundraising for Northwest Harvest – it's not just about the great booty you will see here. This is your opportunity to invest in the Fight Against Hunger!
3. Carefully note the opening and closing times for each auction.
4. **MUST BE PRESENT TO PAY AND PICK UP OR GOES TO THE NEXT LOWER BIDDER.** We can hold the items at our table for you after you pay.

### Silent Auction Rules

**5:30 – 8 p.m.**

1. Use your bid number, not your name, on the bid sheets.
2. You will see an opening bid on every item. You also will see a "Minimum Raise" amount – your bid must add at least the "Minimum Raise" amount to be valid.

3. Bid as often as necessary to win your favs. Be vigilant! But please step away from the table between your bids. No bogarting, 70s children!
4. Our emcee will try to announce “Last Call” **15 minutes** before the Silent Auction closing. Quickly move to Auction Alley to see which bids you may need to boost.
5. Remember, it’s for a really good cause! Our 30<sup>th</sup> annual donation to Northwest Harvest. We have a great reputation with them to protect.
6. At 8 p.m. – put down your pens!

### **Live Auction Rules**

#### **Approximately 8:30 to 9 p.m.**

Now the fun really starts. Be ready. Be quick. Spend like you care about the Fight Against Hunger, like never before. **AND thank you in advance for what you are about to do!**

1. Raise your bidder number high; shout at the auctioneer if he does not see you. Jump up and down – whatever it takes to win that bid!

### **Auctions Closing Time**

#### **Approximately 8:30 to 10:30 p.m.**

1. We will announce when you can pick up any items you won. Processing the bid sheets will take a few minutes. Your winnings must be paid for and picked up by 10:30 or it goes to the next lower bidder in the room. It’s a last man/woman standing situation.
2. To see whether you won, and to pick up your winning item(s), visit the Auction close-out cashier table near Auction Alley, and check out the posted list of winners.

3. Please note: Your numbered written bid constitutes a contract to purchase the item. All purchases are final and not returnable. Auction Officials' decisions are final.
4. Payment must be made by cash, Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express before you leave the building. Items not paid for the night of the auction will be sold to the next highest bidder. So be vigilant! The Auctions paperwork process is expected to run from 8 to 8:30 p.m.
5. Auction Sprinters will provide you with a paper receipt when you have paid for and pick up your items from the Auction Alley Runners' Desk. The receipt is a copy of your bid sheet.

### **Finally ...**

1. Everything is sold "as is."
2. All sales are final.
3. Seattle Singles Yacht Club is not liable for disputes or discrepancies among auction items.
4. Full payment is due the evening of the auction.
5. Nothing can be removed until it is paid in full.
6. All items must be removed from the building by the end of the event.
